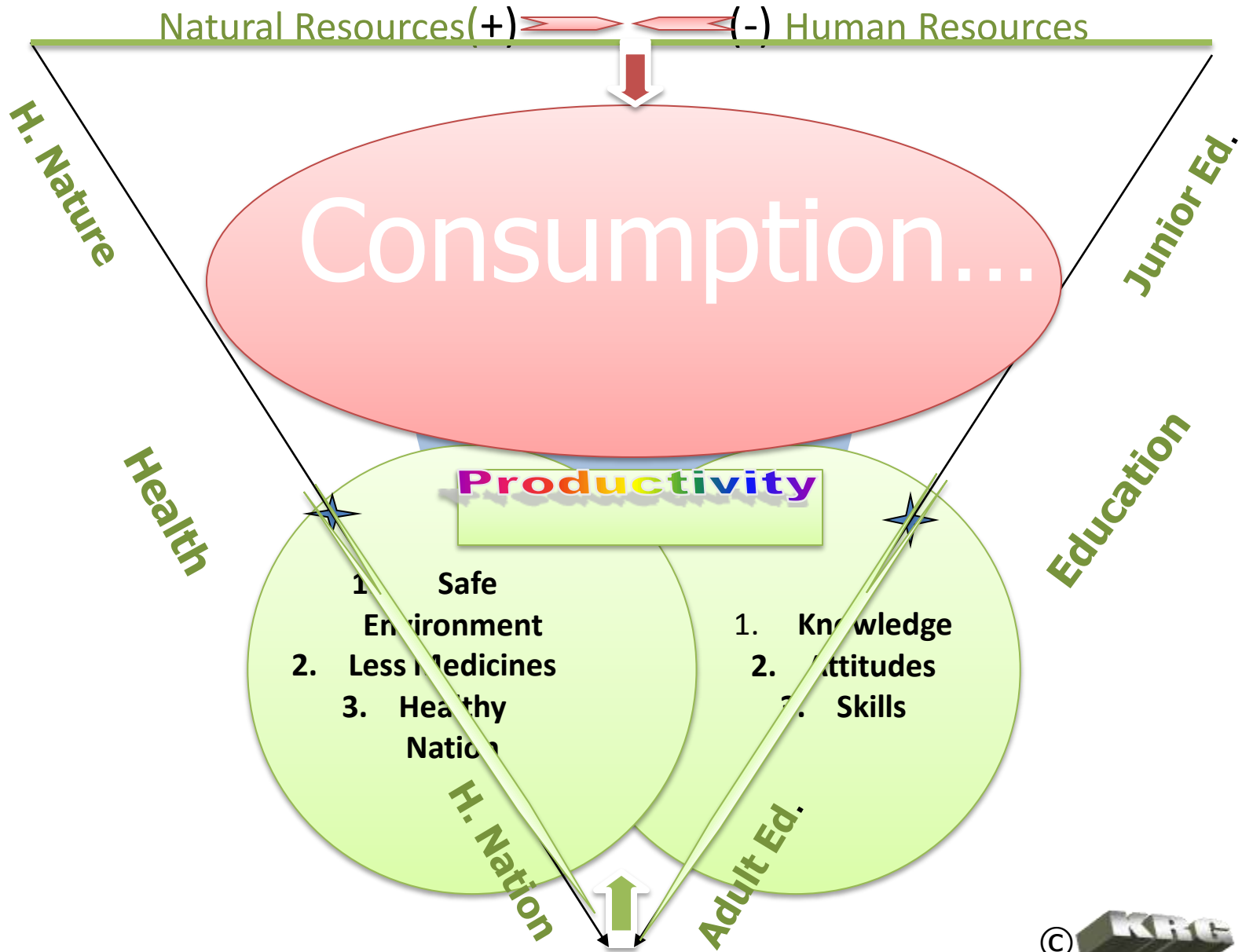
Criteria for Developmental Planning

Productivity: A definition

- Productivity: raising ratio of the value of outputs to inputs
- Development of Natural Resources
& Human Resources
- Productivity # Consumption
 - Productivity = Creating Solutions
 - Consumption = Buying Solutions





KRG-Policy I

- **Adoption of the precautionary principle of "Prevention Before Cure" that implies more consideration for the environmental factor as an indicator for "Health of Nature" and which has to be linked with the "Health of Nation" in Kurdistan whilst both are prerequisite for productivity and long term increase of GDP.**



KRG-Policy II

- **The integration of the concept of protection of nature within the policy of public health care in Kurdistan and towards development of modern management and organization that is relevant to the ongoing sustainable development worldwide.**

KRG-Policy III

- **To outline an action plan for programming adult training & development and within institutional capacity building that has to pave the way for an integrated protection of both nature and nation.**

KRG-Policy IV

- **To articulate a training need analysis (TNA) for personal capacity building with the main emphasis directed towards middle management of the nursing staff that has weakened the status quo system of local health care in Kurdistan.**

KRG-Policy V

- To adopt the cited above principles as future criteria for health care reform in Kurdistan and which may endeavor relevant input supplies of transfer of knowledge, now-how, management & technologies.
